### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Senators and Baysox play game two of a three game series Friday night. The Sens look to rebound after a 5-4 walk-off loss in the series opener. After **Drew Ward** tied the game with a two-run home run in the top of the ninth, the Sox won it in the bottom half on an RBI single by **Aderlin Rodriguez**. It's the Senators' the first walk-off loss of the season. The Sens won the 2016 overall series 9-8 over the Baysox.

### STREAKING FORWARD

Four Senators have recorded hits in at least five consecutive ballgames. **Drew Ward** paces the group, as he extended his hitting streak to eight with a his game-tying home run Thursday night. **Neftali Soto**, **Andrew Stevenson** and **Alec Keller** all extended their hitting streaks to five consecutive games.

### STELLAR STARTING PITCHING

Seven of the first eight Senators starting pitchers have allowed two earned runs or less. After **Erick Fedde** blanked the Baysox through six innings in the series opener, three out of the last four Senators starters have shutout the opposition through six frames. Fedde was also the fifth straight Senators starting pitcher to last six innings while allowing two runs or less.

### TOP PROSPECTS ON ROSTER

The Senators opening day roster features five of the top 30 prospects in the Nationals organization according to Baseball America. **Erick Fedde** (2), **Andrew Stevenson** (5), **Drew Ward** (12), **Oswaldo Abreu** (21) and **Raudy Read** (22) all were included on the list, while Fedde was also named the 52nd best prospect in all of MLB according to the publication.

### MLB PEDIGREE

**Neftali Soto** and **Spencer Kieboom** are the only two Senators players that have Major League experience. Soto appeared in 34 games combined for Cincinnati in both 2013 and 2014, accumulating 42 at bats. Kieboom was promoted to the Nationals last year on September 2, and took a walk in his only plate appearance.

### ROSTER MAKEUP

17 of the 25 players on the Senators opening day roster spent some or all of the 2016 season in Harrisburg. Starting pitcher **Gabriel Arias**, relievers **Jake Johansen**, **Jimmy Cordero** and **Braulio Lara**, outfielders **Yadiel Hernandez** and **Alec Keller**, infielder **Oswaldo Abreu**, and catcher **Raudy Read** are the only players who have not previously played for the Senators. 17 of the 25 players on the roster have spent their entire careers with the Senators.

### TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHERS

**Austen Williams** gets the call for the Senators in game two of the series, matched up against Bowie starter **David Hess**. Williams earned the win in his first start of the season, scattering five hits and two runs across six innings against Altoona. The right-hander started three games against Bowie last season, and went 1-2 with a 4.76 ERA with 12 strikeouts and nine walks. Hess is the 29th ranked prospect in the Orioles organization according to MLB.com. The right-hander received a no-decision after allowing three runs in five innings in his first start of the year at Akron. The 23-year-old pitched all of 2016 in Bowie, and went 0-3 in four starts against the Senators with a 7.89 ERA.
