### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Senators welcome the Bowie Baysox to FNB Field for a short three game homestand beginning Tuesday night. The Senators are coming off a series split in their last series against Trenton after the two clubs split a twin bill to close the series Sunday afternoon. This is the third series of the season between the two clubs and final time the Baysox come to Harrisburg during the regular season. The season series is tied at three wins each after both teams traded series victories at their respective home parks. The two teams do not play again this season until a three game series August 8 to August 10 in Bowie.

### WESTERN EXPANSION

Beginning Tuesday night, the Senators enter a stretch where they play 19 of their next 22 games against Eastern League Western Division teams. The only Eastern Division team they play during that stretch is New Hampshire May 30 to June 1.

### UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY

Game one of Sunday's doubleheader featured a couple Senators players playing in relatively new positions. **Stephen Perez** started in centerfield for the first time in his 536 game minor league career, and it marked just the sixth time he's ever played in the outfield. Similarly, **Neftali Soto** made just his second start and third appearance overall at second base in 1001 career minor league games.

### JOSE IS BACK

**Jose Marmolejos** was added to the Senators roster on an MLB rehab on Friday. Marmolejos began the season on the 60-day disabled list with a strained right forearm. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native played in 33 games for the Senators last season, hitting .299 with two home runs and 11 RBI.

### KHAYYAN HEATING UP

**Khayyan Norfork** has finished with two hits in three of his past six games after he had just one multi hit effort going into that stretch. Norfork has raised his average from .138 on May 2 to .250 this season.

### GLOVER REHAB APPEARANCE

On Wednesday, reliever **Koda Glover** became the first Nationals player to go on a rehab assignment with the Senators this season. Glover allowed one hit and struck out one batter in a scoreless seventh inning, his lone frame of work. The right-hander is rehabbing from a left hip injury and has been on the 10-day disabled list since April 26.

### TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHERS

**Jaron Long** starts the series opener for the Senators against Bowie. Long is 3-3 with a 2.16 ERA this season, the sixth best mark among all qualified Eastern League pitchers. The right-hander scattered eight hits and two runs across six innings against Erie in his last start on May 10, throwing a season high 102 pitches. Bowie counters with starter **John Means**. The left-hander is 1-3 with a 3.75 ERA across seven starts this season. Means suffered the loss in his last start on May 10 against Reading, surrendering four runs over five innings. The 24-year-old started on April 13 against the Senators in Bowie, and gave up two runs on seven hits in four and two thirds innings. Bowie won that game 5-4 on a walk-off single by **Aderlin Rodriguez**.
