TONIGHT'S GAME

The Senators travel to Akron, Ohio to take on the RubberDucks for a three game series beginning Tuesday night. The Senators fell in the rubber match of a three game set with Binghamton on Sunday afternoon, losing 4-3 in eleven innings. The RubberDucks are coming off back-to-back series wins over Portland and New Hampshire. The Senators and 'Ducks play 13 times during the 2016 season, with six games in Akron and seven at FNB Field.

CORBAN CONNECTING

Corban Joseph finished 2-6 on Sunday, making him 10-22 (.456) on the six game homestand with a home run and five RBI. The 28-year-old was added to the roster on May 30 from Syracuse.

NEFTALI STAYS CONSISTENT

With his pinch-hit single in the series finale, **Neftali Soto** has now reached safely on either a hit or a walk in 54 of the 58 games he's played this season. Soto is ninth in the Eastern League in batting average (.313), and third in extra base hits (29).

THEN THERE WAS ONE

The Senators play Akron for the first time this season Tuesday night, meaning they will have played 11 of the 12 teams in the Eastern League. The Senators play their final new Eastern League opponent when they play Portland for a three game series June 23-June 25.

FIRST WALK-OFF OF 2017

Khayyan Norfolk's game-winning RBI single in the bottom of the ninth inning in game two of the previous series gave the Senators their first walk-off win of the season. The win was also the Senators' second when trailing after eight innings, tied for the most among all Eastern League teams.

60th MAJOR LEAGUE REHAB

Joe Blanton became the 60th player in Senators franchise history to appear on a Major League rehab with the club. Blanton, who threw struck out two in a perfect first inning on Thursday, is the third player to rehab with the Senators this season, joining **Koda Glover** and **Chris Heisey**. The Senators had just two Major League rehabs last season from both **Matt Belisle** and **Jonathan Papelbon**.

SENATORS STARTING PITCHER

Jaron Long starts the series opener for the Senators. The right-hander is 5-5 with the seventh lowest ERA in the Eastern League at 2.66 across 12 starts this season. Long took the loss after allowing five runs in six and a third innings on June 7 against Altoona in his previous start. The 25-year-old has limited the opposition to two earned runs or less in nine of his 12 starts this season. Long made one start against Akron in 2016 and allowed five runs in four and two thirds innings.

AKRON STARTING PITCHER

The RubberDucks counter with starter **Matt Esparza**. The right-hander is 5-3 with a 3.10 ERA in 11 starts this season. Esparza started the first nine games of the season with high-A Lynchburg before being promoted to Akron on May 30. The 22-year-old has made two starts with the 'Ducks and has allowed five runs in fourteen innings. Esparza was drafted in the 14th round of the 2015 draft from UC Irvine.
