TONIGHT'S GAME

The Senators welcome the Richmond Flying Squirrels to FNB field for a short three game homestand. The Senators fell in the rubber match to Akron Thursday night, unable to hold on to a one run lead in the eighth inning. Richmond has lost four consecutive games after they were swept in a three game series against New Hampshire. The Senators are 4-3 against the Flying Squirrels this season. The Senators have not won a home series since they took two out of three from Bowie April 21 to April 23.

CORBAN CONNECTING

Since he started his Senators career 0 for 10, **Corban Joseph** is 13 for 31 (.419) with two doubles, a home run and nine RBI. The 29-year-old has recorded a hit in seven of his past eight games and multiple hits in four of the eight games.

COMEBACK KIDS

Wednesday's 12-7 comeback victory gave the Senators their second victory this season when trailing after six innings and biggest come from behind victory after they were down 6-0 at the end of two innings. The 12 runs were also the most scored by the Senators since they knocked off Erie 14-13 on May 22.

UNDER TWO HOURS

Tuesday's game between the Senators and RubberDucks lasted one hour and 58 minutes, the shortest nine-inning game of the season for the Senators. The game marks just the fourth nine inning Senators game since 2005 to finish in under two hours, and first since 2009 when the Senators beat the Trenton Thunder 1-0 in a one hour and 58 minute game.

SEASON-HIGH INNINGS

Jaron Long worked a new Senators season-high eight innings in the series opener, allowing three runs on four hits while also tossing the second complete game of the season by a Senators starter. Ten Senators have thrown at least seven innings this season and Long has pitched five of those games.

NEFTALI STAYS CONSISTENT

Neftali Soto has now reached safely on either a hit or a walk in 57 of the 61 games he's played this season and leads the team with 20 multi-hit games this season. Soto is fifth in the Eastern League in batting average (.320), and fourth in extra base hits (29).

SENATORS STARTING PITCHER

Wirkin Estevez starts the series opener for the Senators. The right-hander is making his Senators debut after he was promoted to the roster on June 15. Estevez was 4-3 with a 3.88 ERA in eleven starts with single-A Potomac before being added to the Senators. Estevez spent all of 2016 with Potomac after having missed all of 2015 with injury. The 25-year-old was originally signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on May 14, 2010.

RICHMOND STARTING PITCHER

The Flying Squirrels send **Jordan Johnson** to the bump opposite Estevez. The right-hander is 4-3 with a 2.76 ERA, the seventh lowest mark in the Eastern League, across eleven starts this season. The 23-year-old took a no decision in his lone start against the Senators this season, allowing three runs in five innings as the Squirrels would go on to win 8-4. Johnson is the ninth ranked prospect in the Giants organization per MLB.com.
